Terry "Bear" A. Wittchow, 72, of N7681 County Road C, Eldorado, died Wednesday, February 9, 2011, at home. He was born on November 25, 1938, in Fond du Lac County, a son of Irvin and Fern Bluemke Wittchow. Terry served with the United States Army. He owned and operated Terry's Bar in Eldorado for 30 years. He was an avid Green Bay Packers fan and he enjoyed watching his grandchildren play sports. On March 25, 1961, he married Marlene A. Lueptow.
