



## Thomas D. Blagoue

Thomas Daniel Blagoue, 61, of Fond du Lac, went to his Savior, with family at his side on Tuesday, November 9, 2021.

Tom was born May 4, 1960, in Fond du Lac. Tom was a graduate of L.P. Goodrich High School. While he was able to work, Tom helped to manage Tuckers Meat Plant, producing quality ground beef patties for his family's business, Tuckers Restaurants.

As a youngster, Tom was a gifted athlete, excelling at most every sport he took up. Tom loved all motorsports. He was a champion snowmobile racer, piloting his Merc Sno-Twister to many junior division victories as he raced at Eagle River and many other venues throughout the Midwest.

Tom loved music and became an excellent amateur drummer, often spending evenings playing with his friends. Tom's family was always amazed at what an "epic" Christmas gift buyer he was. Tom left no stone unturned in his shopping and it is no exaggeration to say that he always found the perfect gift.

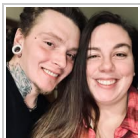
