Thomas W. Lohmann, 74, of Fond du Lac, died Monday, April 6, 2015, at home. He was born on October 30, 1940, in Cedarburg, Wisconsin, a son of Lloyd A. and Erna Viesselmann Lohmann. Thomas graduated from Cedarburg High School, Class of 1959. He attended Northwestern University. On October 2, 1965, he married Sharon K. Ramsey in Hobart, Indiana.
