Verna Irene Miller, 90, a resident of the Fond du Lac Lutheran Home, passed away on Friday, August 29, 2008. She was born on March 12, 1918, in South Byron, a daughter to Arthur and Lena Sonnenberg Kosloske. On November 1, 1939, she married George J. Miller in Fond du Lac. Verna was employed at the Infant Socks Company after graduation from high school and later as a hostess at Schreiner's Restaurant. She then worked in the library at Woodworth Junior High School and Rosenow Elementary School until her retirement. She later worked for Wegener Office Supply, served as a volunteer at St. Agnes Hospital and was a self-employed seamstress for most of her life. She was a charter member of Salem United Methodist Church, was a certified lay speaker for the Wisconsin Conference, served as a Sunday school teacher for more than 20 years, was a Past President of the Council of Church Women, and was a Past President of the Tri-Cs Women's Society.
