Viola “Vi” H. Kowalski, 85, of Lakeview Estates, Fond du Lac, died Sunday, April 27, 2008, at Hospice Home of Hope, Fond du Lac. Viola attended Cedarburg Public Schools and following her education, she worked for two years as a stenographer at Kiekhaefer Corporation. On October 5, 1945, she married Joseph A. Kowalski.
