Virginia L. Illetschko, 95, died Sunday, July 11, 2010, at Walnut Grove Suites, Fond du Lac, after a brief illness. She was born on December 31, 1914, in Milwaukee, a daughter of the late Clarence F. and Blossom White Bennett. Virginia married Edward A. Riedel on February 8, 1936, and he preceded her in death in 1951 due to an accident. She later married George B. Illetschko on November 14, 1953, who preceded her in death in 2000. She was a devout member of St. Peter's Ev. Lutheran Church, Fond du Lac, and was an active girl scout leader in her earlier years. She enjoyed bowling, card games, bingo, and other social activities. She is survived by three children: Blossom (William) Kreil of Door County, James (Diane) Riedel of Milwaukee, and George (Karen) Illetschko of Fond du Lac; eight grandchildren; eight great-grandchildren; three brothers: Neil, Lynn (Marge), and Clarence Bennett. She was preceded in death by a brother, Donald Bennett, who died while serving his country during World War II; and a sister-in-law, Rosemary Bennett.
