



## Virginia Marie Liebelt

June 25, 1916 - February 21, 2007

Virginia M. Liebelt, 90, formerly of Fond du Lac, died Wednesday, February 21, 2007, at Parkview Health Center, Oshkosh. She was born on June 25, 1916, in Manitowoc, Wisconsin, a daughter of Frank and Mary Ulovitz Stueber. Virginia was a graduate of Manitowoc Lincoln High School. On December 17, 1938, she married John K. Liebelt in Manitowoc and lived there for three years. They moved to Fond du Lac in 1942 and farmed until 1970. She was employed in food service at Taycheedah Correctional Institution and Fond du Lac Healthcare Center. She volunteered as a grandma at Lighthouse Kiddie Kampus Daycare, taught Sunday School at the former Gospel Tabernacle Church and also taught crafts at Spencer Lake Bible Camp. Virginia was a member of Lighthouse Christian Church. She is survived by five children: David (Muriel) Liebelt, Robert (Marj) Liebelt, Richard (Eydie) Liebelt, Judith (Rudy) Wojahn, all of Fond du Lac, Kathryn Johnson (Dan) of Oshkosh; 13 grandchildren and 14 great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, John on July 19, 1965, and three half sisters. The funeral service will be at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, February 24, 2007, at Lighthouse Christian Church, 401 South National Avenue, Fond du Lac, with the Reverends Brent Balken and Liandro Arellano officiating. Burial will be at Ledgeview Memorial Park. The visitation will be 4:00 – 7:00 p.m. on Friday, February 23, 2007, at Mach Funeral Chapel, 31 East Division Street, Fond du Lac and on Saturday at church from 10:00 a.m. until the time of service.
