



Wallace G. Humphreys

April 7, 1930 - August 4, 2022

Wallace G. Humphreys, 92, of rural St. Cloud, Wisconsin, entered heaven August 4th, 2022. Wallace was born in Klamath Falls, Oregon to George and Besse (Frint) Humphreys on April 7, 1930. The family later moved to Emmett, Idaho where his Uncle Bob and Aunt Lois Frint mentored and guided him. Following his school years, Wallace enlisted in the US Army, serving in Korea. He remained a proud veteran, instilling in his children his love of country. On August 23, 1952, Wallace married the love of his life, Wanda Louise (McMillan) Humphreys. They would have celebrated their 70th wedding anniversary this August. After miscellaneous occupations, Wallace began working for the Fuller Brush Company as a door-to-door salesman and within a short time, successfully managed Fuller Brush's highest life-time producing division. His 38-year career led to many sales awards and recognitions. His faith and love of God was forever the cornerstone of his life. He shared his faith often and influenced and impacted many around him by his life. He was a member of Lighthouse Christian Church.

Wallace was a loving and very proud father of five children: Gail (Larry) Day, Robert (Karen) Humphreys, Christopher (Terri) Humphreys, Vincent (Robin) Humphreys and Lawrence Humphreys. He was a beloved grandfather to 10 grandchildren and 14 great grandchildren.

Wallace and Wanda bought a farm in rural St. Cloud and together they farmed for many years. He ended his farm career selling his prized vegetables at "Wally's Market" on County Road T where he enjoyed meeting his

"customers" and cultivating friendships. The farm became the place of generational memories, competitive games and children's laughter. They established many valued friendships during their 25 years of wintering in Arizona and memorable trips to Alaska. His love of fishing grew after retirement, with Alaska being his favorite place to fish and explore. He is survived by his adored wife, Wanda Humphreys and his brother Paul (Sue) Humphreys of Eads, Tennessee. He is preceded in death by his parents and his siblings: Virginia, June, Vee, Helen, Georgia, Esther and Billy.
