Wanda R. Koehntop, 94, a resident of Tower View Villa, Rosendale, died Sunday, March 11, 2007. She was born on June 20, 1912, a daughter of Charles and Gertrude Lewis Roth in Fond du Lac. She was employed with the Soo Line Railroad during WW II as an engine wiper and later worked for 10 years as an egg candler at Bowman Dairy in Ripon. On March 30, 1957, Wanda married Alvin C. Koehntop in Chicago. She was an active partner with her husband in Koehntop Construction for more than 40 years, and co-owned and operated the couple's farm, Koehntop's Little Farm. Wanda was a member of St. Stephen's Lutheran Church, Rogersville, and was a member of the ELCA Women. She was a Lifetime Member of the Order of Eastern Star, Lodge 144, Waupun, being active for over 50 years. Wanda and Alvin both enjoyed hunting, fishing and coaching the Green Bay Packers. She is survived by her daughter-in-law Sharon (Doug) Pearson of Oshkosh; 2 granddaughters, Dr. Kandace (Neil) Schrimsher of Atlanta and Karla (Dr. Rex) Knauf of New Holstein; 3 great-grandchildren, Max and Miles Knauf and Aubrey Schrimsher; 1 niece, Mary (Tom) Schweiss and family and her grandchildren of the heart, Lolly Smith, "Danny Boy" Holdridge and Chris Kromm.
