William "Bill" D. Olig, 70, of Fond du Lac, died on Wednesday, February 2, 2022, at his home.

He was born on May 7, 1951, in Fond du Lac, the son of Elmer and Teckla M. Wagner Olig.

He was a graduate of New Holstein High School, Class of 1969. He was a veteran of the United States Air Force, serving from 1969-1972. On June 8, 1974, he married Ruth A. Schneider, at St. Louis Catholic Church in Fond du Lac.
