William F. Peachy, 81, a resident of Eldorado, died unexpectedly, on Saturday, March 3, 2007, at his residence. He was born on October 20, 1925, in Rosendale, a son of Adin and Verna Burleton Peachy. Following high school, William enlisted in the United States Army, serving in the 3rd Armored Division under General George S. Patton in Germany during World War II. Following the war, he became employed with National Rivet in Waupun. On September 25, 1948, William married Madonna D. Henning at St. Peter's Lutheran Church, Eldorado. Together they farmed in the Town of Eldorado until 1978. He then returned to National Rivet until his retirement in 1990. William was a member of St. Peter's Lutheran Church, Eldorado, serving on the church council, was a member of the church choir and enjoyed attending Bible study. He was presently serving as Post Commander of Rosendale V.F.W. Post 10195 and was a member of Getchel-Nelson Post 210, The American Legion, Waupun.
