William "Bill" Prickette, lost his battle with dementia on March 16, 2026.

He was born in Elcho, WI, on May 23, 1941, the son of Edward and Veronica (Thurber) Prickette. Bill graduated from Antigo High School in 1959 and immediately enlisted in the Army. While serving his time, Bill pitched baseball for the armed forces in Germany, with the Augsburg Mustang Dragons.
